
Micro-level Analysis

TWO-YEAR INTEGRATED CLASSROOM PROGRAMME (TYCP)

Our Two Year Integrated Classroom Programme is an ideal course for providing a sound foundation in class XI. It strengthens the base of the students as it is a known fact that all the competitive exams contain more than 50 % questions from class XI syllabus. This is a 700-hours integrated programme comprising of 8 units. It is divided into two academic sessions (4 units in each session). The Doubt Clearing Cell is the one stop solution to all the queries of students preparing for MEDICAL as well as Board related topics. The teachers are available throughout the day to clear any doubts of students on all working days.

Common Practice Test (CPT) : It is a weekly test conducted all over India among Narayana students. It gives our students unique opportunity to perform weekly and see their rank potential among the real MEDICAL aspirants. It is the life line of every programme offered by Narayana. Besides keeping the students competitive and motivated, it helps them to realise their full potential.
